Unique period home in charming village setting with river views. Guadalajara Ref. S43

Refurbished nineteenth century home enjoying a bucolic setting on the Camino del Cid, just 90 minutes from Madrid – country home - Guadalajara.

Dating back to the early nineteenth century, this unique period home was completely renovated in the 1980s. Nestling in a quiet, scenic village in Guadalajara countryside, this altogether charming property is a chance to own a little piece of history.

A stately manor house in an idyllic village location, this elegant property offers a chance to own a little piece of history.

Located in a small village in the Alcarreño region, the village lies on the legendary Camino del Sid, clustered around the Tajuña river just an hour and a half from Madrid. It's a lovely setting for a summer residence —and the original owner of this elegant, characterful home clearly thought so too.

The house has a total built area of 470 m2 and is arranged on two levels, plus an attic and wine cellar. On the ground floor, we find a reception hall, living room-diner, bedroom, kitchen with working fireplace, guest bathroom and wide veranda with commanding views of the medieval road that winds alongside the river.

The basement is shared between a wine cellar and a second kitchen carved out from the bedrock. Ascending a staircase drenched in natural light from the impressive cupula above our heads, we reach a hallway leading to a billiard room, four large bedrooms with a cosy snug and a family bathroom. The attic reveals four further bedrooms and a WC.

In addition to this unique period home, the plot also contains an old stone warehouse with a footprint of 270 m2, split between two open-plan levels and the roof space. Requiring complete renovation, it has potential to be converted for vehicle parking, with access from the same street as the house itself.
